

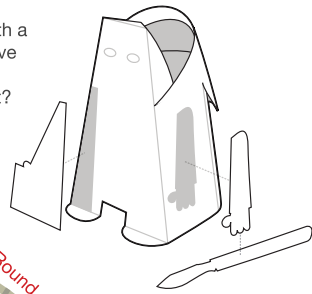


KILLER

This paperkit has some interesting building-techniques. It can be cut best with a precision-knife. Greasing and folding before you glue will be necessary to have Killer look solid. And also pre-curve the paper slightly and a bit, since this kit technically is about curves. We thought, horror isn't for children anyway, right?
